Tournament Information: Saturday May 15 and Sunday 16, 2021 8.00a.m. to 4.00p.m.

Tournament rules: All techniques to the face, head and neck must have absolute control. The referee panel will penalize the competitor if hand techniques touch the face, neck or head for all 17 years old and younger. "Light skin touch" with foot is allowed for all divisions. Age 18 and up: non injurious, "light skin touch" with hand is allowed.

Age Divisions: 5 & under, 6/7, 8/9, 10/11, 12/13, 14/15, 16/17, 18 and Up.

All divisions are separated by gender. - Some divisions may be combined or subdivided based on number of competitors, height and/or weight, at the tournament director's discretion

Categories: Beginners (10, 9, 8, Kyu): 0-1 year training
Novice (7, 6, 5 Kyu): 1-2 years training
Intermediate (4, 3, 2, Kyu): 2-3 years training
Advanced (1 Kyu and Black Belt) 3, +4 years training

Mandatory Equipment: Mask mandatory for ALL attendees: athletes, spectators, staff, and officials
White Karate-GI, Red & Blue Belt, Leather fist guard (red and blue), Mouth guard and groin protector (male)
* Shin guard, Foot Pads (mandatory) in divisions 8 years and older. Except in the beginner and novice divisions of boys and girls 7 and under.
* Headgear and Chest protector (female) are optional.

COVID – PRECAUTIONS

These are not normal times and this will not be a “normal” tournament. We must accept there will be changes and procedures that must be followed in order to comply with State, Federal and local requirement, in addition to creating the safest environment possible while still competing in a Karate Tournament.

This is not the place to make your personal expression or protest related to COVID. If you cannot or do not want to follow the procedures and requirements listed below, then please DO NOT participate in this event.

Competition will be held over two days to limit attendance.

Divisions 12-13 and above Advanced will compete on Saturday according to the calendar.

Divisions 8-9 and 10-11 years Advanced, plus all other divisions on the Schedule will compete on Sunday.

Face coverings will be worn by ALL Attendees.

Athletes are allowed to not have a face covering while they are on the tatami actively competing.

Coaches will wear a face covering at all times unless seated in the coaching box actively coaching.

Officials will wear a face covering at all times.

Volunteers will wear a face covering at all times.

ALL spectators will wear a face covering at all times.

ALL spectators accompanying athletes should be chaperones of the athlete.

Everyone will wear a face covering at all times without exception, except athletes while competing.

Spectators are only allowed to go on the day their athletes compete.

Kumite equipment will be wiped with disinfectant before each bout.

Hand sanitizer will be provided at each score table and throughout the venue.

Temperature checks will be conducted on athletes and coaches at check-in. Elevated temperature will prevent entry into the event.

Temperature checks will be conducted on everyone, including all Officials, Volunteers and Spectators; each time they enter the competition venue. Any elevated temperature will prevent entry into the venue.

Athletes are restricted to have TWO (2) spectators per athlete to reduce attendance.

Competition will be webcasted on a schedule to allow spectators to watch their athletes remotely.

Divisions will be spaced throughout the day to allow limited attendance. Participants should only be in the venue while their athlete is competing.

Rules and Regulations Kata & Kumite

****Degrees or levels for divisions in the League:**

FIRST TIMERS: We say Kyu or white belts that are presented to a tournament for the first time, **One Time**.

BEGINNERS: Ninth and Eighth Kyu who have a Year of practice.

NOVICES: Seventh, Sixth and Fifth Kyu or one year to two years of practice.

INTERMEDIATE: Fourth, Third, Second and First Kyu or spent Two years to Three years of practice.

ADVANCE: First Kyu and Black Belts, with more than Four years of practice.

KATA

- *Kata Simultaneous execution for all divisions except the 12-13 Up Advance divisions.
- ***Athletes will not be allowed to register in more than one division**
- *All Beginners & Novice must perform Kihon Kata and can repeat the same Kata.
- *All Intermediates cannot perform advanced Kata (refer to the list), can repeat the Kata all round.
- *All advanced level must perform a different Kata in the medal rounds than the one prior to previous round.
- *If Int./ Adv. Combined, they can repeat the same kata all rounds.
- *WKF divisions (Advance 12-13 Up) must perform a different Kata each Final.
- ***DO NOT disqualify any Beg / Nov divisions under any circumstances.**
- *If any competitors in this category comes to halt, have them repeat the kata then proceed to Hantei.
- *Disqualification due to the lack of a bow(s) will be only on Black Belt Advance Divisions 12-13 Up.
- *Numbers Runs all Kobudo divisions.
- *Participation medals are **ONLY** for those who did not place in Kata or Kumite.
- *All divisions will have two third place finalists in Kata.
- *Beginner, Novice, and Intermediate divisions will not have repechage.
- *All advanced matches have repechage.

KUMITE

- ***Athletes will not be allowed to register in more than one division**
- *Only licensed referees can function as the center referee or corner judge.
- *Only licensed judges can work as corner judges.
- *Judges can only indicate points and jogai, unless the referee says otherwise.
- *Referees **CAN NOT** asks for point reconsideration.
- *Fights last 1 ½ minutes for everyone 12 years or younger.
- *Fights last 2 minutes for 12-17 years of age and 18 & up non-elite divisions.
- *Fights last 3 minutes for all WKF/Elite male divisions.
- *All hand to face contact must be penalized for everyone under 17 years of age.
- *Skin touch is allowed for those 18 and over with gloves.
- *"Light touch" head kicks are permitted for all ages.
- *All competitors must wear shin pads in addition to the gloves.
- *All divisions will have two third place finalists in Kata.
- *In youth divisions, if the shin pads are too big, they are allowed to just use the footpads.
- *No jewelry is permitted.
- *Headgear is optional for all divisions except those in WKF/ Elite divisions.
- *All advanced matches 12-13 years and up will have repechage.
- *Beginner, Novice, and Intermediate divisions will not have repechage.

**Nota: DO NOT disqualify any Beginners or Novices divisions under any circumstances.
If any competitors in this category comes to halt, have them repeat the kata then proceed to Hantei**

In divisions other than USA Team Trial divisions, competitors may repeat the same kata
In every round, except in all advanced divisions, of every age category, competitors must
Perform a different kata in the final (“medal”) round.
